Changes and Improvements since September 1, 2024

Online evidence system
for the ongoing journal
issues preparation (Google
disk, shared documents).

**Updated journal publication
template since 2025** (16 pages
maximum; obligation to cite at
least 5 sources from WoS and
Scopus not older than 3 years;
ORCID is required).

**Emphasis on satisfactory
level of American English
language** (reason for refusal).



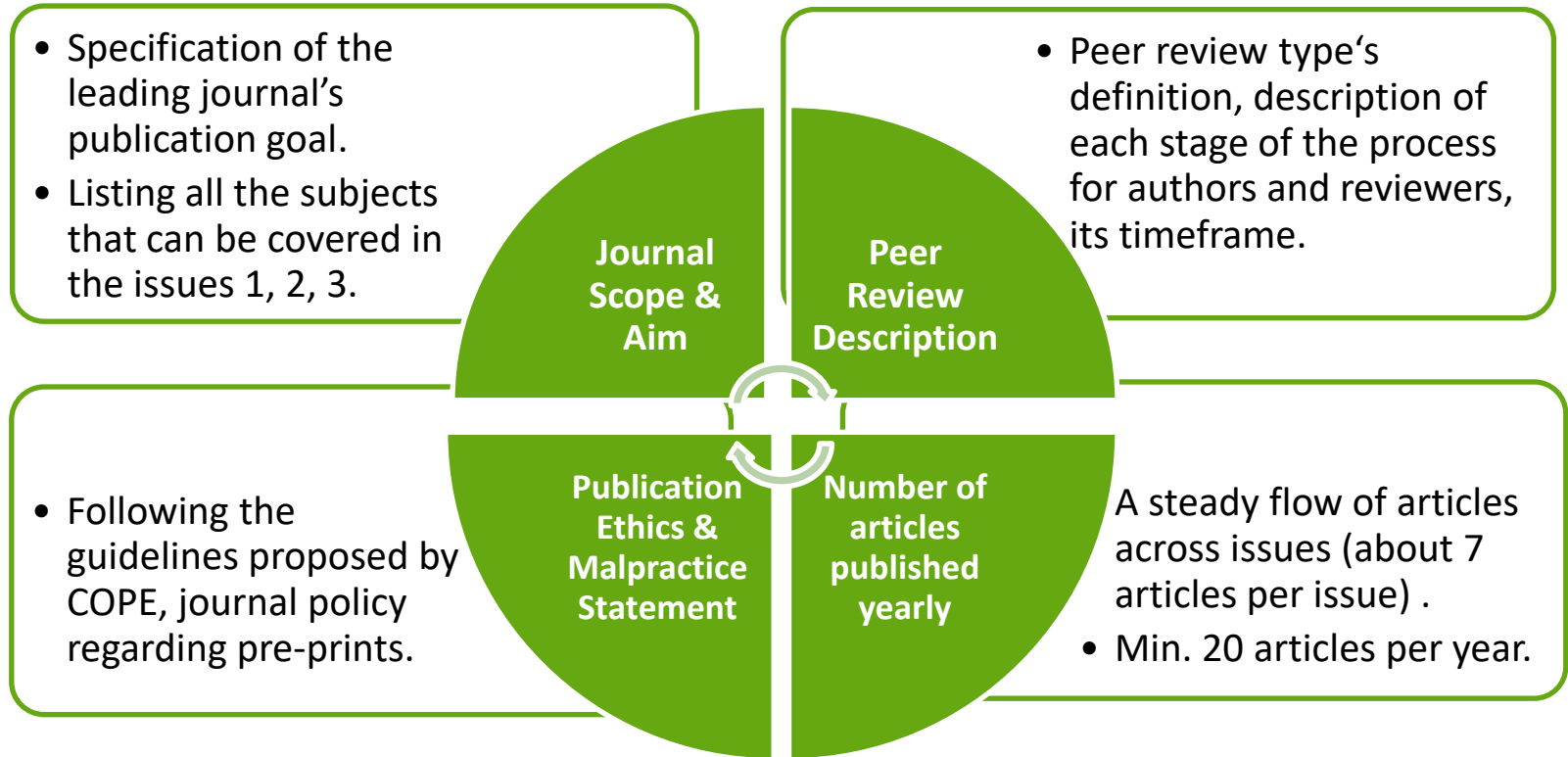
**Exchange of unnamed
contract with reviewers
electronically** (signed
scan by e-mail).

**Expansion of reviewer
database** (9 from Czechia,
1 from Poland, 1 from
Slovakia, 1 from Algeria).

Current Challenges in Cooperation with Authors and Reviewers

- **Inconsistency of the article with the new template**
(the page limit and abstract length are not met, unclear research gap, poor methodology).
- **Attracting new reviewers**
(only **every fifth new potential reviewer** contacted was interested in cooperating).
- **Attracting new authors**
(more involvement of **journal coordinators** is needed; authors published **in the last 5 years** are being addressed 3 months before the article submission deadline).
- **Spreading awareness of the journal abroad.**
- **Increasing diversity in the geographical distribution of authors and reviewers.**
