Aim of the project

The aim of this project is to enable, via lectures, Czech and Polish students of the Technical University of Liberec and the Wrocław University of Economics (EU) to gain up-to-date information on job offers on the Czech and Polish job markets. The lectures will focus on problems which arose with the onset of the financial and economic crisis.

The lectures will be given by experts from the Technical University of Liberec, the Wrocław University of Economics, WGRiT in Jelenia Góra. Further, representatives of the Labour Office in Liberec and Jelenia Góra will participate, as well as students who wish to share their personal experience with these job markets. The students will also present business opportunities in the Czech Republic and Poland.

Not only will the lectures concentrate on the general impact of the crisis on the job markets in the world and the Czech Republic, but they will also concentrate on particular exposures of the crisis on the job market in the Euroregion Nisa.
