Participants are expected to present:

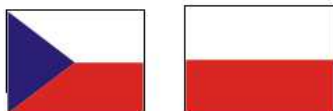
- technologies elaborated by universities including these already implemented and those ready for introduction,

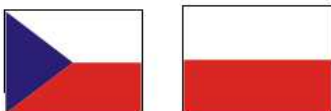
