Senior citizens from Saxony and Poland who are interested in the sustainable and cultural development of the Polish-German border region.

Institutions, organizations, and enterprises in the fields of culture, health, environmental and nature protection, and crafts, which, together with senior citizens, contribute to the sustainable development of the region.

Planned activities in the project

- One-day inaugural conference 80 seniors (40 participants from Poland and 40 participants from Germany)
- 15 two-day workshops on "Intangible Cultural Heritage" (throughout the project implementation period):
- Culinary—traditional cuisine, herbs and regional dishes featuring regional products from the region. Old cookbooks
- Traditions, dances, costumes, and music bring people together.

- Artists, writers, and painters who have left their mark on the region.
- Traditions connect generations what holidays are there and how are they celebrated?
- German/Polish language course for seniors.





- Medical students from partner schools took part in activities that enabled them to acquire the desired competences as graduates, improve their employability in the Euroregional labor market, and improved their skills in caring for patients in the border region.
- Two-week internships abroad in Poland and the Czech Republic in healthcare and social welfare institutions;
- comparison of healthcare systems during five two-day away workshops, resulting in a methodological publication;
- exchange of information on innovative methods and good practice during two joint conferences;

Projekt CZ-PL Transedu Interreg V-A Republika Czeska - Polska 2014 – 2020

The project an online platform containing information for teachers and school administrators in the cross-border *region*, has been implemented jointly by the Karkonosze University of Applied Sciences in Jelenia Góra and the Higher and Secondary Medical School and Business Academy in Trutnov.

Duration: September 2021 – August 2023

 The project, implemented during the period from September 2021 to August 2023, involved the creation of a joint Polish-Czech online platform. It contained materials relevant to schools in the cross-border region. These included recordings of Polish-Czech online meetings of teachers and school administrators, including examples of good practices in ensuring the quality of education during the pandemic, recordings of meetings on other current topics, lectures by experts, and multimedia materials showing interesting aspects of work in selected institutions on both sides of the border.
